

Something New VII – Site Descriptions

Site 1 – Winslow Way & Erickson Avenue

Site Description: This site is located on Winslow Way, the city’s Main Street, near the Town and Country Grocery Store. The street includes wide sidewalks, rain-gardens, street trees and pedestrian amenities.

The sculpture will be viewed by residents and visitors who frequent Winslow Way for shopping, community events and who travel this route to and from the Seattle – Bainbridge Island Ferry Terminal. There are several other permanent public art pieces located along this route. The street is home to many galleries and is the primary location of the First Friday Art Walks. The pedestal is in a landscaped area between Winslow Way and a 10” wide sidewalk. The sculpture will be most frequently viewed looking north, east and west from walks and south from the street.

Platform Shape and Dimensions: Circular; 26” diameter, 30” height. Refer to the Attachment 3 for size and connection details.

Maximum Weight of Sculpture: 3,500 lbs.

Maximum Dimensions of Sculpture: No size limitations, but sculptures shall not protrude into the pedestrian circulation path and the concept designs must be approved by the City Engineer to ensure structural stability.



Site 2 – South Madison Overlook (Next to Doc’s Marina Grill)

Site Description: This site is located on City property near the intersection of Madison Avenue South and Parfitt Way. This largely paved pedestrian space overlooks Eagle Harbor and sits between commercial buildings and restaurants on the ground floor.

The space includes shade trees, benches, planters and directional signage. The sculpture will be viewed by residents and visitors who frequent the commercial waterfront for dining, services and access to the marina. The platform is located in a paved public space at the terminus of South Madison Street. The sculpture will be most frequently viewed looking south with Eagle Harbor as the backdrop. Pedestrians in the plaza will be able to circulate around and view from all directions.

Platform Shape and Dimensions: Square, 3’0” by 3’0”. Refer to Attachment 3 for size and connection details.

Maximum Weight of Sculpture: 7,000 lbs.

Maximum Dimensions of Sculpture: No size limitations, but sculptures shall not protrude into the pedestrian circulation path and the concept designs must be approved by the City Engineer to ensure structural stability.



Site 3 – Bainbridge Island City Hall (Next to Front Entrance)

Site Description: This site is located at the main entrance to City Hall. The pedestal is on the side of the City Hall building, across from the Island Fitness Athletic Club.

Bainbridge Island City Hall is the site of continual foot traffic and civic activity. The sculpture will also be viewed by a variety of island residents, local merchants and contractors who visit City Hall. Anyone who walks through the parking lot on their way to the athletic club, as well as visitors who are attending events at Bainbridge Performing Arts Center, located directly behind the City Hall will view the sculpture in this location.

Pedestal Form and Dimension: Circular, 3'W x 5'L x 16"H.

Maximum Dimensions for Sculpture:
No size limitations, but sculptures shall not protrude into the pedestrian circulation path and the concept designs must be approved by the City Engineer to ensure structural stability.



Site 4 – Bainbridge Island Waterfront Park

Site Description: This site is located in Waterfront Park below the Bainbridge Island Senior Community Center. The pedestal will be along the path below the “Hand in Hand” sculpture (which was purchased by the City of Bainbridge Island as part of Something New introductory year exhibition in 2018!

The Waterfront Park is the site of continual foot traffic and community activity and is one of the most popular civic and social gathering places for island residents and visitors. It welcomes annual festivals, summer performances, special events, picnics, music performances, and more. It provides sunny lawn areas for play and relaxation and easy access to the water’s edge for boating and tranquil views of Eagle Harbor!
